### CAMERON PARISH PORT HARBOR & TERMINAL DISTRICT

February 27, 2018

The Cameron Parish Port Harbor & Terminal District met in regular session on Tuesday, February 27, 2018 at the Port Board Building, Cameron, Louisiana at 6:00 o'clock PM.

Port Director Clair Hebert Marceaux gave a general report on meetings with Water Institute, executive director of the Nature Conservancy, various companies looking for sites in locating their operations in Cameron Parish, T & L Solutions, Cameron Parish School Board's Director of Curriculum and Instruction and LA Works, Senator Blade Morrish and Capt. Brett Palmer regarding proposed Calcasieu-Cameron Navigation District

legislation, attended IMCAL executive committee and full board meeting, Chamber Southwest Annual Banquet, February Port Association of Louisiana Meeting, the LIDEA board meeting, Venture Global LNG open house, Oak Grove open house in Johnson Bayou, Louisiana, spoke to the regional young professionals group Fusion Five, Lake Charles Petroleum Club and Gulf Coast Industrial Group about the Cameron Parish Economy.

Under Correspondence the board review and discussed the Calcasieu-Cameron Navigation District. District Attorney Jennifer Jones, Clair Heber Marceaux, Howard Romero and Wendell Wilkerson updated the board on their meeting with Senator Blade Morrish concerning the Calcasieu-Cameron Navigation District legislation. Mr. Bourriaque, Parish Administrator informed the board they scheduled meetings to discuss the legislation with the elected parish officials. He also spoke to the board about the Calcasieu Salinity Project that should be taken into consideration. Discussion and Public Comment Period followed. Mrs. Miller was appointed to work on the committee with Mr. Romero, Mr. Savoie, and Mr. Wilkerson. Discussion and Public Comment Period followed.

On the motion of Mr. Romero, seconded by Mr. Dupont and carried with a unanimous vote, the board agreed to draft a resolution in opposition of the creation of Calcasieu-Cameron Navigation District. ("Exhibit A")
